

## Arizona Library Association Conference

The State Library was a major contributor to the annual Arizona Library Association Conference held in Mesa in November 2007. The State Library was not only a Platinum Sponsor of the conference, but also created an exhibit booth. The theme for the booth was “Preserves and Provisions: A Sampler Plate from Your Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records” and the booth highlighted several of the ways the State Library serves libraries throughout the state by featuring four programs: the Arizona Memory Project, Building a New Generation of Readers, ONEBOOKAZ, and Government Information in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. In addition to the four featured programs, all the divisions provided brochures, flyers, and other written materials to be distributed.
