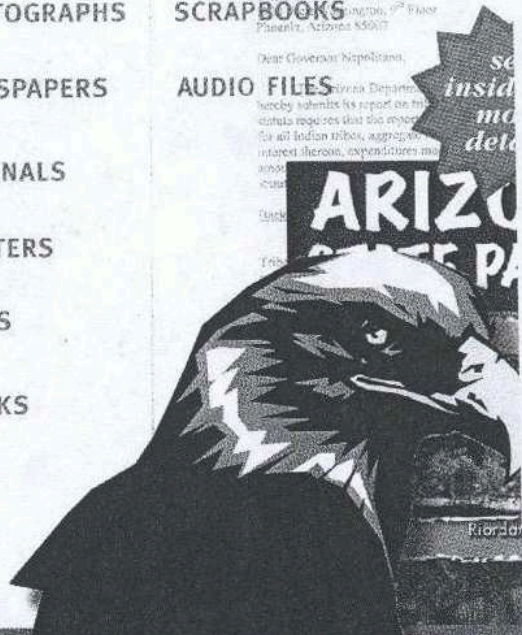

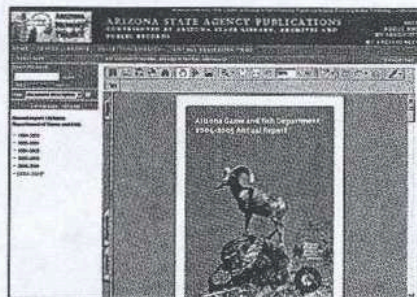
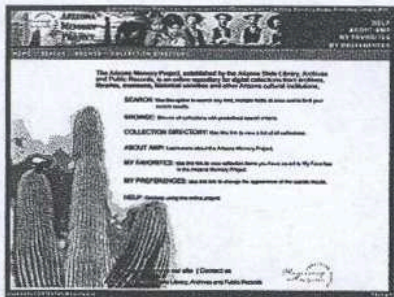
CONTENTdm: meeting all your digital collection needs

Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records

The Arizona Memory Project, established by the Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records in 2005, is a central online repository that provides easy access to cultural treasures that chronicle Arizona's past and present.

Arizona archives, libraries, museums, historical societies and other cultural institutions all are invited to contribute items. The collection includes historic photographs, maps, objects, archival documents and publications. For example, the State Library and Archives uses CONTENTdm to store digitized and born-digital state agency publications, opinions of the Attorney General and Arizona-related federal publications and congressional reports.

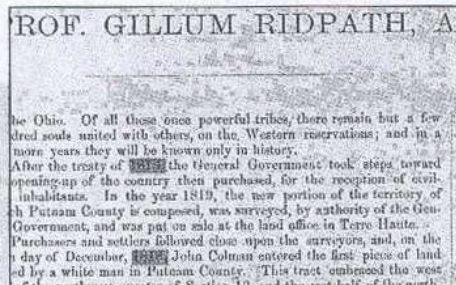
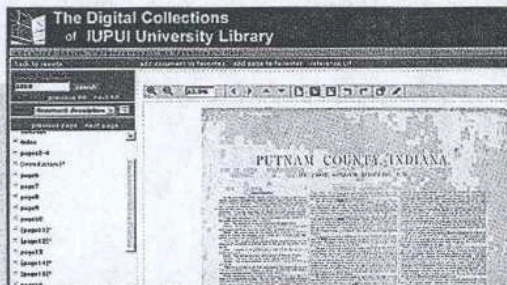
CONTENTdm is a flexible, digital collection management system that works for all your digital collections, from archival documents, reports and books to formats such as maps, photographs, audio and video.

Since CONTENTdm handles all formats viewable through standard Web browsers and plug-ins, your end-users can easily search for resources across all your collections at once.

Using CONTENTdm, you can build your digital collections quickly and easily. To assist you with every phase of your project, CONTENTdm has powerful features and tools, such as batch processes, templates and global editing capabilities.

Additionally, CONTENTdm offers features specifically designed to help you manage documents, including:

- Streamlined document creation, preview and loading
- Comprehensive editing functionality
- A time-saving batch import feature
- An optional OCR (optical character recognition) Extension
- Batch import of typescripts and PDF transcripts for full-text searching
