Internship Duties and Responsibilities May Include:

- Serving as a Museum Ambassador
- Creating learning activities for youth
- Working with the Museum Guild on fundraising and other projects
- Supporting the Virtual Experience Manager in enhancing the virtual visitor's experience.
- Collaborating with the Onsite Experience Manager to enhance the museum experience
- Preparing for and staffing special events
- Working with the Collections Manager to preserve Arizona History. Become involved in all aspects of collections management.
- Increasing outreach and community engagement

Internship Learning Objectives and Benefits:

- Interns will get an inside look at a government and nonprofit agency.
- Interns will learn about civic engagement and Arizona governmental history.
- Interns will complete specific projects designed to provide direct experience in their career field.

Internship Requirements:

- Students from all fields of study, both graduate and undergraduate, are welcome to apply.
- Students must be 18 years old or older.
- You must be able to climb stairs and be on your feet for long periods.
- You must be creative, flexible, and interested in civic engagement.
- You must have availability weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
