



Secret Codes!

When creating Secret Codes for use at your library events, here are some tips that will make the code easier for participants to remember:

- Do not include spaces, dashes or underscores
- Use one word, all in lowercase letters
- Examples: “tempemagic” or “serlrobot”

When hosting a library program, it is helpful to display the Secret Code somewhere that is easy for the attendees to see. Here are some possible ways of displaying the Secret Code:

- Write it on a white board
- Create a laminated poster that can be wiped and reused for each program
- Print it out on ticket-sized slips of paper to hand out to attendees
